

Session Two

Elements of Spontaneous Disciple Making

Disciple-making is an ongoing process, not a program or an event. There are several critical elements that make-up the disciple-making process. We will study each Element.

Elements of a Spontaneous Disciple Making Process for Explosive Growth

1. **Vision and Desire come from God** We are to be obedient to Jesus Christ and fulfill the Great Commission He gave us.
2. **Prayer** to know God's specific will and direction for you. Develop a Prayer Calendar Team of 30 people to pray with you and for your ministry.
3. **Engaging Lost People in the Community**; serving the lost and showing Christian love through doing deeds of kindness.
4. **Find People who are interested and open to the gospel.**
5. **Begin a Discovery Group** with the family or friends of these people.
6. **Begin other Discovery Groups** through their families and friends.
7. **Baptize** all who receive Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord.
8. **Establish each new Christian** in their faith using Dynamic Basics One-to-One.
9. **Recruit and develop a leader** for every new Discovery Group using Dynamic Discipling One-to-One and ongoing Bible study to develop their character and skills.
10. **Expand the present Church ministry** or plant new Churches from these Discovery Groups.
11. **Continue to Mentor** the Discovery Group leaders and Church Planters that are under your care.

Vision and Desire

Is God giving you a vision and a desire to begin a disciple-making ministry? If so, the following sessions will give you clear step by step directions and equip you to begin.

Are You Ready?

Prayer

Before you begin to do anything, you need to spend much time in prayer personally to seek God for His Vision and to have a Desire to do His will. You need to discern God's will and direction and not just ask God to bless your plans.

You also need to recruit your team of Prayer Partners. Your team will pray for you as you find people who are open to the gospel. As you begin your Discovery Group they will pray for the needs of people. It is important to pray against the forces of darkness.

Prayer Calendar

You could make a list of 30 people and pray for one each day of the month. Call (or email or text) them and pray with them and for them. Share that God is leading you to reach out into your community. Share any specific requests you have and ask them to pray for you. Encourage them to develop a prayer calendar of their own. You should mobilize many other people (hundreds if possible) to pray for you as you develop and implement your vision to reach your community. Keep them informed of needs each week.

Prayer Calendar

Start your Prayer Calendar now. List 30 Christian friends that you will pray with and for - one each day of the month. (Example: I will pray with John on the 5th day each month). You could include your spouse, children and friends. Before you write their names ask God to call to your mind the names of the people He wants you to pray with and for. Start with as many as you can and add more at a later date as God brings them to mind.

Spend time now on your Prayer Calendar. Add Contact Information at a later time.

When you complete your list spend time praying for the name on today's date.
